### **District Policies**

Transparency and a clear understanding of school and district mission, vision, curriculum, rules, procedures, and policies is key to a working partnership between school and home. At the beginning of the year families are overwhelmed with a ton of information in emails, letters, and handbooks. It would be impossible to read all of the policies and remember them. This section is intended to make families aware of policies or school procedures that are pertinent currently.

We have noticed several students utilizing smart devices, such as smart watches during the school day. Unfortunately, we are unable to monitor what content on these devices. They are a distraction to learning. Please see the Mehville School District Technology policy below. In accordance with this policy, no students are permitted to utilize cell phones or any communication devices at school.

#### **Communication Devices**

"Communication devices" shall be defined as pagers, cell phones, smartphones, laptop computers or any other wireless devices using wifi or mobile broadband connectivity. Students who bring electronic items to school do so at their own risk and are responsible to secure the item from theft or loss.

Students shall not use, display or turn on personal communication devices during the regular school day, including instructional class time, class change time, breakfast or lunch.
